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## A. [All] Road Safety Concern at Gate D

The safety of our students remains our top priority, and we need parents' assistance to manage the crowding situation at Gate D during arrival and dismissal times.

We have observed concerning situations where the narrow pavement becomes overcrowded with parents and domestic helpers waiting near Gate D. This congestion has forced some students to step onto the road to navigate around the crowd, creating potentially dangerous situations. We have witnessed several near-miss incidents that could have resulted in serious accidents.

To ensure our students can arrive at and leave school safely, we kindly request your cooperation:

- Please avoid congregating directly at the sides of Gate D during peak times
- Consider waiting at the void deck opposite the school gate
- If you must wait near the school, please be mindful of maintaining clear pedestrian pathways

The school continues to prioritise student safety through regular road safety education and safety reminders. It is important to have a collaborative effort between the school and our parent community to create a safe environment for our students. Together, we can ensure that every child arrives at and leaves school safely each day. We look forward to your continued support in keeping our students safe.

## B. [All] Health Awareness Week 2026

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## C. [All] Update Health Forms and Prepare for Upcoming Screening

The Health Promotion Board (HPB) will be visiting our school for the yearly **health screening** from **Wednesday, 8 April to Monday, 20 April 2026**.

As part of the **Grow Well SG (GWSG)** initiative, P1 to P5 children will receive a **Health Plan** as part of HPB's screening. This plan will include **personalised lifestyle advice** tailored to your child's interests and habits, based on both the health screening and the **Child Lifestyle Questionnaire** you complete.

### What You Need To Do

- Complete pending **Health** and **Lifestyle** forms via the **Consent Portal** (link below).
- Update vaccine records on the **National Immunisation Registry (NIR)** website (link below).
- **Parents of Primary 5 students:** Submit Hardcopy health booklets to the school for review of records by **Thursday, 2 April 2026**.

### Prepare your child for Health Screening

- Remind them to eat a good breakfast and drink water to reduce the risk of dehydration.
- If your child wears glasses or contact lenses, remind them to bring these along.

If you do not wish for your child to take part in HPB's health screening, please email to HPB at [Contact\\_YPS@hpb.gov.sg](mailto:Contact_YPS@hpb.gov.sg). Parents who opted out in kindergarten, please write in again if you still wish to opt out.

*The health screening results are based on selected basic assessments and provide only preliminary findings, which may differ between individuals. These results do not replace a medical diagnosis. If you notice anything unusual or are concerned about your child's health, you must consult your family doctor or a relevant healthcare professional for proper evaluation and care.*
