## A. Health Awareness Week 2025

Snack break	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students will be given a 15-minute break between 8.00 am to 9.15 am during classroom activities. Do pack some light snacks and a water bottle. School canteen will be closed for that day.</li><li>• Students are encouraged to have a heavy breakfast before coming to school.</li></ul>

Do make the necessary arrangement to pick up your child/ward at the end of the celebrations. Students with after-school student care and school bus arrangements will proceed accordingly after dismissal.

## C. PSLE Oral Examinations

PSLE Oral Examinations will be conducted on **Wednesday, 13 August 2025, and Thursday, 14 August 2025**. Primary 6 students must be in school for their oral examinations. An information slip with your child's /ward's schedule will be issued soon. Please ensure your child/ward arrives on time for the examination.
